Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entries must be on the enclosed blank or an official AKC entry form. Photocopies must include the Agreement and Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, who-ever may make such errors.

-Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, duplicate entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Show Committee.

-Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The show secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring.

-If, because of extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

-No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

-Entries must be on the enclosed blank or a reasonable facsimile thereof.

Declination of Entries - The BTCSC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the BTCSC or any official thereof.

OAK CANYON PARK is a privately owned facility.

GATES WILL OPEN at 6am each day for non-camping exhibitors, and close at approximately 10pm each day.

WILDLIFE IS ABUNDANT in this area. You may see hawks, owls, coyotes, raccoons, skunks and even mountain lions. Please plan accordingly. **DO NOT LEAVE FOOD/BAIT OUT OVERNIGHT**

DO NOT LEAVE DOGS UNATTENDED in x-pens in the parking lot. They will be fine inside the fenced park.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. The owner or agent entering a dog in an obedience and/or rally trial does so at his own risk and agreed to abide by the rules of the AKC and the *Obedience Regulations*.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The BTCSC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The BTCSC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the BTCSC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is injured after the closing of the trial.

Full entry fee will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date/time.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
